

Angels on Horseback Barn Rules are designed to create and maintain a clean, safe and fun environment for people and horses. Working with horses is a high risk activity. The following rules must be adhered to at all times by participants, volunteers and anyone who visits Angels on Horseback.

- All paperwork MUST be completed and submitted in order to ride at Angels on Horseback. This includes riders, volunteers, board members, etc. No Exceptions!
- No horseplay in the barn or around the barn. This includes running, shouting, throwing projectiles, waving objects, wrestling, fighting and chasing.
- All riders must use a ASTM-SEI approved helmet while mounted, or doing ground work, and use safety stirrups or wear hard-soled shoes with heels.
- No riding inside the Barn Aisle.
- No one is permitted in the barn, or in the adjacent paddocks and pastures, unless an AOH trained volunteer is present.
- No one is permitted in the Stall areas unless accompanied by an Instructor or having received prior consent from the Director.
- Absolutely NO smoking or open flames is permitted in the barn, or anywhere on the Angels premises.
- No one is allowed to handle program horses, feed or pet horses, unless supervised by a trained volunteer.
- No hand feeding anything to the horses. No Treats allowed, we feel it makes the horses mouthy and pushy.
- Barn aisles must be kept clean and free of obstructions.
- If you get it out, please put it away!
- In case of Fire, please proceed to the far side of the parking lot, getting far away from the fire, and fire trucks. Staff will locate and use fire extinguishers if needed.
- In case of Severe Weather, such as Tornado Warnings, Earthquake, etc where immediate shelter is needed, please go the Tack Room.



## ANGELS ON HORSEBACK

- No abusive, threatening, or violent behavior towards people or animals will be tolerated on Angels on Horseback premises.
- Alcohol and illegal drug use is prohibited on the Angels grounds, or at any Angels on Horseback hosted events.
- NO SMOKING or use of open flames is permitted anywhere at Angels on Horseback.
- Children and siblings on the AOH premises must be supervised at all times by their parent/legal guardian.
- No person will be permitted to ride a program horse until he/she has submitted to AOH a completely processed set of the required forms for the current year.
- No one may enter a pasture containing horses unless accompanied by a trained volunteer.
- No Pets allowed.
- No bare feet or sandals are allowed around the horses at any time, by anyone.
- No horseplay in the barn or around the barn. This includes running, shouting, throwing projectiles, waving objects, wrestling, fighting and chasing.
- No one may bring a non-program horse onto the AOH premises without prior permission from the Director.
- Turn out lights if you are the last to leave.
- Keep all Barn and Arena gates closed at all times.
- In case of Fire, please proceed to the far side of the parking lot, getting far away
  from the fire, and fire trucks. Staff will locate and use fire extinguishers if needed.
- In case of Severe Weather, such as Tornado Warnings, Earthquake, etc where immediate shelter is needed, please go the Tack Room.
